Hello Dancers,

The Advantages of being the Editor means we didn't have to send out the November issue of the *Modern Square* till after the Fall Festival.

We made one BIG change to the *Modern Square*. You will no longer receive 12 issues of the E Edition. We (the Executive board) made the decision to only put out the E Edition when the printed edition is put out. These will come out 4 times a year: November, February, May and August. Reports will need to be sent in by the 5th of the month prior to each of these months. Prompt Renewal ... If you wait until the last minute to renew your subscription, or sign up for The Modern Square (including at a Subscription Dance very close to the 10th of the month preceding the month of issue), you may MISS one or more issues, and may NOT be able to get a copy of the missed issues, even if you had material published in it.

Remember ... If you do not contact the Circulation Manager when you have a delivery issue, then there is no way for him to rectify it. The problem may be in the database record or with the Postal Service. Both can be fixed.
