IS YOUR CLUB'S INFORMATION CORRECT? DOES ANY OF YOUR CLUB CONTACTS NEED UPDATING

Before traveling call ahead first

A club could cancel a dance at the last minute!

NOAA Weather Radios are available at most electronics/department stores. Be sure to get one with the **SAME** Warning Alarm Capability and a battery backup. The voice of the National Weather Service alerts you to severe weather 24 hours a day. Also available is **weather.gov** Choose Arkansas for the forecasts, watches, warnings, and advisories.

Be sure to get your reports in to the Editor before the 5th of the month preceding issue going out.

Example: Send in report before Oct 5th for November issue.

Changes in *Modern Square*:

We are trying to find a new format so we can afford to mail out more issues per year at a lower cost so we can afford to do so. People do not like getting the *Modern Square* quarterly but each time we mail these out the cost is almost \$200 per printing with postage.

4 times a year the cost is \$800.

With 43 paid subscriptions getting an issue 4 times a year that is a cost of \$4.66 per issue. With each paid Subscription of \$20 paying the \$18.60 for the cost. If we send out an issue each month it would cost us \$2400 a year with a cost of each issue of still being \$4.65 but we would still be taking in 43 subscriptions of \$20 each equaling \$860 and paying out \$2400. This would mean we would be in the red \$1540 a year. The ASSDF just can't afford that kind of money.


