President's Message

Tonia and I are missing square dancing and seeing everyone, but still working behind the scenes. We are serving as Vice-Chairman of Special Events for the National Convention in Jackson, Mississippi, scheduled for next June. We have a meeting in Jackson, Mississippi, on September 11-12 and look forward to working with other passionate square dancers. We know our Arkansas Dancers will support the dance in Jackson, Mississippi, next June.

The ASSDF officers will make a decision whether to hold the ASSDF State Dance in Texarkana or cancel/reschedule this year's event by mid-September. We will send out an email blast as soon as the decision is made, as the safety of our dancers is our primary concern.

Did you know? In 1991, the Arkansas General Assembly designated the square dance the official American folk dance of Arkansas. A concurrent resolution authored by Senator Jack Gibson of District 35 introduced the measure; it won quick approval and was signed into law by Governor Bill Clinton on February 7, 1991, as Act 93.

This month our spotlight is on Phil Moorehouse. I was surprised we had 2 of our officers had their roots out west; however, Phil has them beat, starting way out west!

According to Phil, my passion with square dancing started with my parents. They first started dancing in the late sixties, while we were stationed at Subic Bay Naval Base in the Philippines, with their first club the Bataan Twirlers. I loved watching them and wanted to dance to, but I was too young and had to wait.

We had moved to Hawaii and my parents started dancing with the local clubs. I had to wait until I was 12 to start lessons, but I got permission from the caller to start at 11 since I would be close to 12 when I graduated. The first club I belonged to was the Ocean Waves. After going to the Hawaii State Square Dance Conventions, we went to our first National Square Dance Convention with nearly 40,000 of our closest square dance friends at Anaheim, California in 1976.

After trying my hand at calling on amateur night, I joined my first caller's school with Bud Garrett. My father had learned in Bud's first class, and is still the only caller calling from that class. Six months later, I started in class, and I am the only caller still calling from that class.

In Hawaii, I called for the Advanced Paradise Dancers, Bachelor and Bachelorettes, Diamond Heads n Sides, and Teen Twirlers. I was also 1 of the 2 callers featured at the Hawaii State Convention. Dad and I had called at many festivals throughout the islands, and even taken tour groups with us. The most interesting places were on the top of an active volcano in Hawaii, and on the wettest spot in the US on Kauai.

I had followed not only in my father's footsteps, but my grandfathers as well. My grandfather was a traditional caller, and well known musician in the Indiana area. He would play in the band, and call as he played. After about 17 years, we left Hawaii, and moved to the Quad Cities on the border of Illinois and Iowa. I had started calling again for a club in Iowa City, and guest spots at the local clubs in the area.

My calling and dancing had slowed down when I joined the National Guard, and went to Basic and Advanced training in the Arm; and then transitioned to the Air National Guard, and learned to be a C-130 Pilot. I had moved to Arkansas in 1991, for the flying job with the Arkansas Air National Guard, and still called and danced when I could. Dad and I still traveled back to Hawaii for many years, to call for the Volcano Hot Foot Stomp. My daughter, who has called with my dad and myself, several times in Hawaii and Colorado, was really responsible for my full return back to calling. She started learning to dance on her own, and I was encouraged to rejoin the dancing in Arkansas.

The Arkansas square dance family has welcomed my family and I into their ranks, and I have truly enjoyed it. I am currently calling in the Arkansas regional area, and call for the Blue Belles and Beaus, Heber Springers, Maverick Mixers, and the Star Steppers.

As I think everyone would agree, we all look forward to getting back to dancing!!

Look forward to dancing with everyone soon!

FROM THE EDITOR



Sadly, there've been more postponements/cancellations, from COVID-19. The Star Steppers Labor Day Dance with Jet Roberts, was **cancelled**; and a decision will be made by mid-September, on whether or not the ASSDF Fall Festival in Texarkana in October, will be held. Updates will be sent out via Email, Twitter, and on the Websites. Again, **please call before you travel!!** There's a statewide directive for wearing masks in public, if social distancing can't be done; and unfortunately, "you can't social distance and dance".

While dancing has been limited, the ASSDF is publishing **The Modern Square**, E-Edition and print edition, each month. The deadline has been changed to the **14**th **of the month, before the month of** issue. Note that the print edition can **NOT** continue without subscriptions and ads. Right now, we have a total of 57 print subscriptions; with 48 expiring in both November and February combined, and the other 9 expiring in the other months combined. On average, for every 10 Reminder Cards sent out, only 2 renew. Please send your renewal check (\$20 per year) to the Treasurer (not to me), make it payable to ASSDF, and sign it. It costs **extra** to re-mail it to the Treasurer...or to return it to the sender, if it has the wrong amount. Plus, the bank **won't** take it, if it's **not** signed.


