Prompt Renewal ... If you wait until the last minute to renew your subscription, or sign up for The Modern Square (including at a Subscription Dance very close to the 10th of the month preceding the month of issue), you may MISS one or more issues, and may NOT be able to get a copy of the missed issues, even if you had material published in it.

BLUE BELLES & BEAUS

JUDSONIA

Have you ever gotten through with a tip and then tried to remember the name of the call you had a little trouble with, (so you could ask for help) and can't remember it? That happens to me all the time. Heck fire, I can't remember the names of most of the calls I do – I just do them. I think that's the way with most "old" or should I say "seasoned" square dancers. I guess there are some people that actually know each step/position you need to be in to complete a call. I call them "challenge" dancers" or callers. I, on the other hand, am just challenged. In any case, the more floor time you have, the more each move becomes a natural reaction that you don't really need to think about – it just happens; sooo **get out there and dance** as often as you can. AND, since the recent callers school in Batesville, we've got some budding new callers that need your support, so let's make it a win-win stitch and have visitations and dance with them. 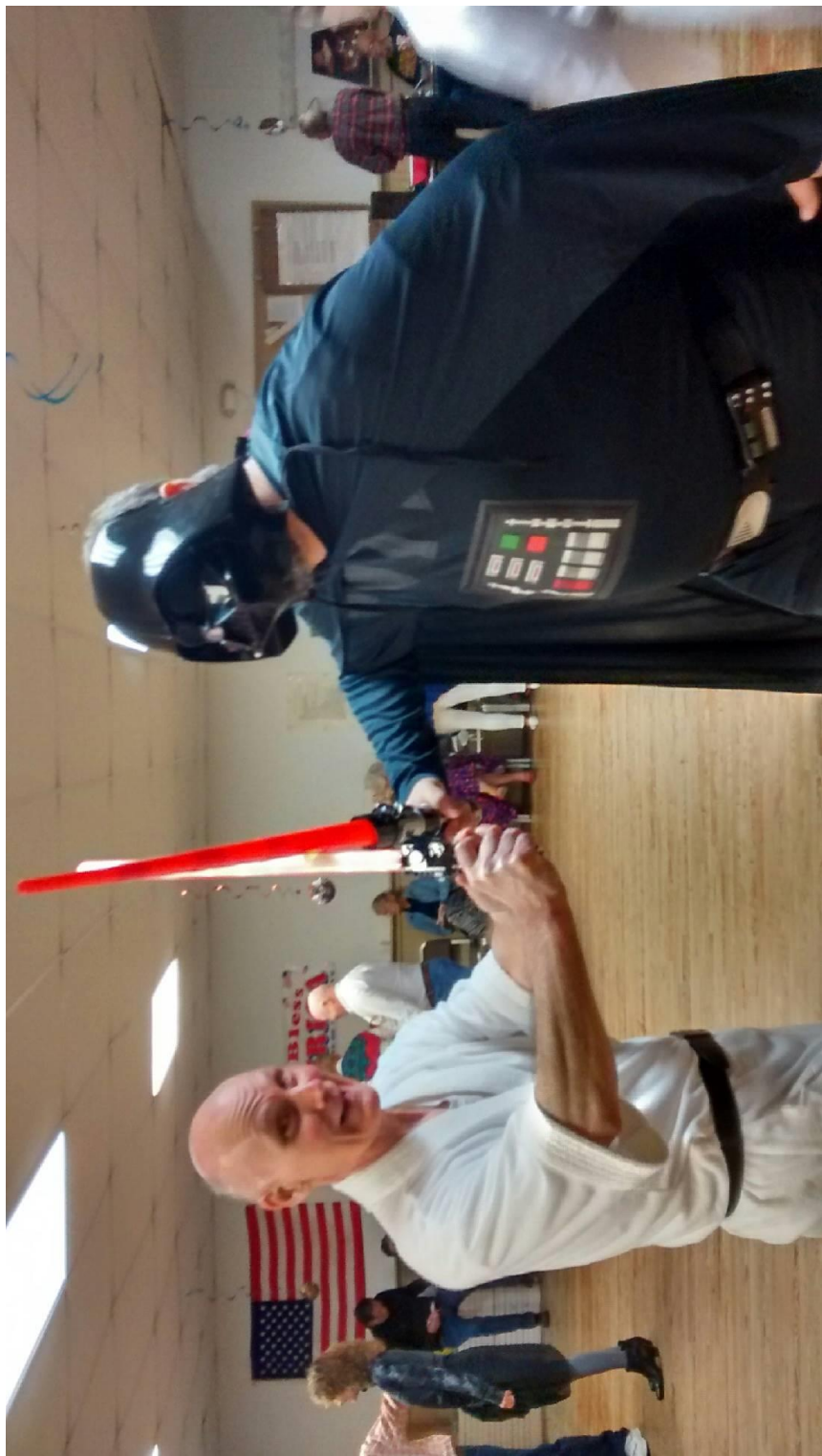
